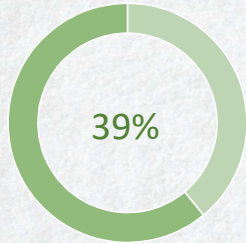
- Improved opportunities for citizen to have choice & control & to take personal responsibility.

What we have done so far...

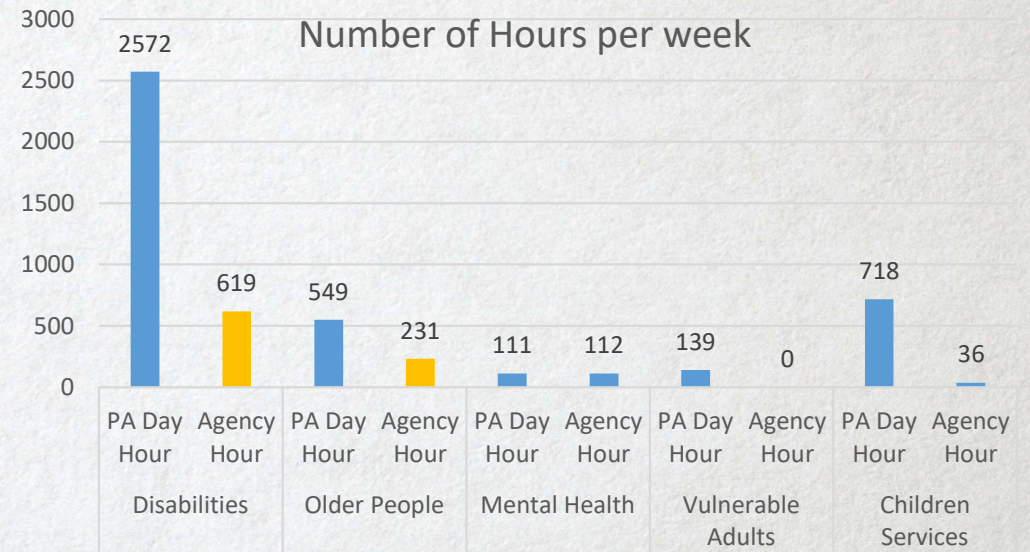
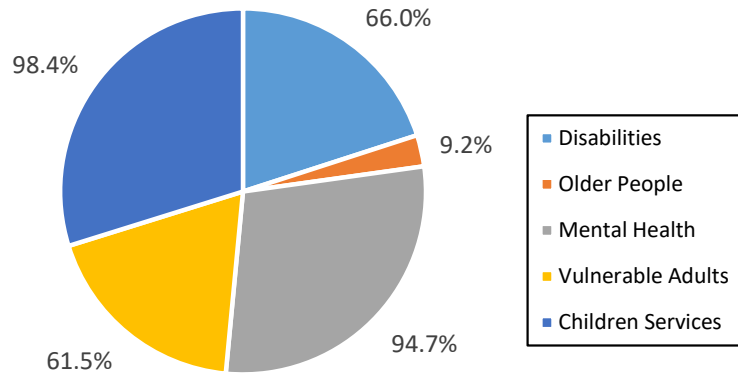
- Developed an In-House Support Service

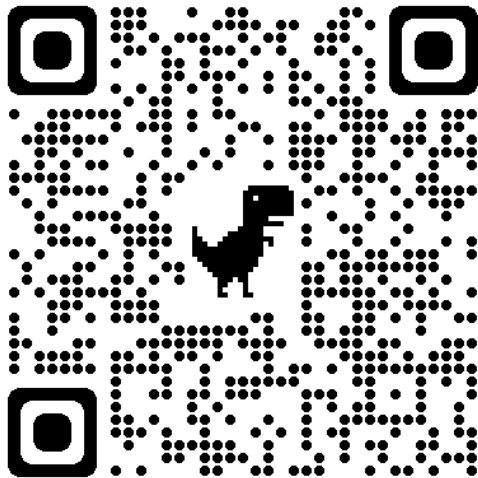
