Regional Partnership Boards in Wales

Thank you for your letter, delivered by email of 24 January 2024, in which you requested information regarding the Regional Partnership Boards of Wales, specifically the “*latest reports on all seven of Wales RPBs, including either the last five years of accounts or the latest audit of their spending and finances*”.

The Auditor General for Wales does not have any statutory functions that relate specifically to the RPBs, therefore does not audit their accounts and the requested information is not held per se. It may, however, be helpful to note that the Auditor General does have a role in relation to wider value for money programmes of work, which includes examination of issues relevant to RPBs and the flows of funding to them.
